



Description: Rural footpaths beside Royal Military Canal, across farm fields and alongside coastal road. Scenic views; several lakes and lots of water courses, good bird watching opportunities.

Pett Level Nature Reserve at start of walk includes WWII look out (closed but reachable with extreme care on rough, steep path) and interesting history boards.

Take care: Two big stiles, several bridges with steps up. Grazing livestock (sheep, possibly cattle sometimes). Potentially muddy in winter. Roadside verge uneven in places; coastal path unsurfaced. Caution crossing road.

Difficulty level: Moderately challenging because of stiles and length.

Parking: Small free car park; layby parking along Pett Level Road.

Nearby postcode: TN35 4HF

Public transport: Bus stop nearby.
