Description: Combining two contrasting parks at the eastern end of Eastbourne seafront. Princes Park has a beautiful lake, attractive planting, interesting water features, plus a café and toilets. Sovereign Park is a Site of Nature Conservation Importance that preserves a pocket of natural shingle for the historic plants. Linked via a seafront stroll and an underpass.

Take care: Smooth surfaced paths suitable for all except a grassy stretch in Princes Park, can easily be avoided to stick to paths. Two road crossings, one a zebra crossing, one an underpass.

Difficulty level: Very easy.

Public transport: Bus stops nearby.

Parking: Pay & display car parks at either end: Royal Parade (BN22 7LW), Prince William Parade (BN23 6RT).
